ABOUT WFD RSA YOUTH SECTION





The World Federation of the Deaf Regional Secretariat for Asia (WFD RSA) endeavors to develop cooperation and solidarity among WFD members in the Asia area, and to improve the situation of the Deaf by stimulating exchange of knowledge and experience concering issues common to the region.

WFD RSA Youth Section (WFD RSA YS) Works closely with WFD RSA to strengthen the leadership skill of Deaf Youths in Asia. Currently, WFD RSA YS has 18 member countries.



ABOUT IAWDYS





After Indonesia Association Welfare for the Deaf progressed, IAWD created a new section of youth named is IAWDYS (Indonesia Association Welfare for the Deaf Yourh Section) on November 10, 2004. With the intention of its establishment, IAWD wants the field to be able to empower children and youth ranging from 9 to 35 years old with the aim of building the seeds of the younger generation of Deaf people to be better and qualified for the country of Indonesia. As time went on 4 years later, IAWDYS was appointed to host the 4th WFD RS A/P in Sukabumi, West Java on June 22-27, 2008 successfully attended by 35 Asian countries and 12 European countries. Finally, IAWDYS became a trusted part for deaf youth in Indonesia.



ABOUT WFD RSA YOUTH CAMP



In the 1990s, the World Federation of the Deaf (WFD) Youth Camp was held mainly in European contries, making it difficult for the Deaf youths from Asian region to participate. therefore, Malaysia hosted the 1st Asia-Pacific Deaf Youth Camp to make it easier for the youth in Asian region to participate. Until 2003, the name of the camp was changed to the 3rd WFD Regional Secretariat for Asia/Pacific (RSA/P) Youth Camp and was hosted by the Japanese Federation of the Deaf. After this camp, prospectus of the Camp was drafted by WFD RSA/P and was adopted at the 16th WFD RSA/P representatives meeting that was held in 2004 in Jakarta, Indonesia. The camp is for the Deaf youth aged between 18 to 35 years, from each country member of WFD RSA/P. Each WFD RSA/P member can only send up to 4 Deaf youth. the camp objectives are to help Deaf youth to gain leadership skill, exchange ideas and learn about advocacy work, enhance the pride in Deaf culture, identity, and history, build a network and understand the culture in Asia-Pacific region. The WFD RSA/P was renamed to WFD RSA, with effect form 1 January 2013.









The main objectives of the RSA Youth Camp are:

- Offering Deaf Youth, a chance to acquire new knowledge and skills.
- Training Deaf youth in organization and leadership activities.
- · Networking between Deaf youth of different countries of the Asian region.
- Cultural exchanges between different nationalities.

The emphasis of these objectives of the RSA Youth Camp is to give Deaf youth an apportunity to meet ohter Deaf youth from other Asian countries, and to exchange experiences, languages and cultures. In this environment, Participants can learn about international issues with tolerance and appreciation for all cultures.



Theme:

SEWELAS "Sign Enthusiasm, Learn, Adjust, and Socailize"

SEWELAS means eleven in Javanese, Sewelas stands for Signing Enthusiastically, We Learn, Adjust, and Socialize. This logo depicts a camp where Deaf can sign with entusiasm, We learn, adjust and socialize leadership roles, and cultural exchange in various countries.





Pick-up and drop-off of campers at airport/station

But please do not worry, you can transit with 3 international airport options in Indonesia as follow: Soekarno-Hatta airport, Jakarta (CGK), Juanda airport, Surabaya (SUB) or I Gusti Ngurah Rai airport, Denpasar (DPS)

Access of Transportation Application:



In Indonesia, Grab App. serves vehicle orders such as motorbike taxis (GrabBike), cars (GrabCar), taxis (GrabTaksi), couriers (GrabExpress), food delivery (GrabFood), and carpooling (GrabHitch Car).





The Go-Jek App. provides 17 types of services: Go-Ride, Go-Car, Go-Food, Go-Mart, Go-Send, Go-Box, GoTix, Go-Med, Go-Massage, Go-Clean, Go - Auto, Go-Glam, Go-Bills, Go-Pulsa, Go-Pay and Go-Point. Apart from that, the Go-Jek application is also equipped with facilities Go-Pay, Go-Bills, Go-Point, and Go-Pulsa.






VISA TO INDONESIA
